The AlpSIB project is elaborating as its main deliverable a “Common Methodology” that, starting from the chances and obstacles in the individual countries, identifies the common opportunities and challenges for implementing SIBs, with a special focus on the Alpine Space countries.

The purpose of the TAB meetings is to have moments for open discussion among policy makers, practitioners, foundations, experts, stakeholders and other institutions, in order to finalize the methodology document.

The current state of the “Common Methodology” is the result of confrontation tables run at national level and of a first Transnational Advisory Board (TAB) meeting that took place in Munich in July 2018.

What is planned? What could be envisaged for the upcoming future?**
