What is TOUCH?

Aim

To create the first outcome fund in the Piedmont region, in Italy, with the plan of disseminating the financial model in other Italian and European regions.

Activities

Capacity buildings supporting service providers;
Provide policy guidelines;
Engage in research;
Engagement with public and private sector.

Objectives

- **strengthen** the outcome-based financial ecosystem in Italy;
- **improve** the skills of social enterprises in the Piedmont Region;
- **implement** outcome measurement approaches for all stakeholders involved in outcome-based contracts;
- **provide** insights into the most effective solutions for tackling the NEET issue.

How long?

TOUCH Project has the duration of two years. December 1st 2024 - November 30th 2026
